HOLIDAY TIPS FOR KIDS CHEAP EATS

Use those two minute noodles but make a meal of it!
Get the kids to slice up some vegies...use whatever you want.

Add some cooked chicken, fish or protein of choice.

Fry it up and add your cooked noodles.

Add the flavouring provided (if desired) or a sprinkling of good old curry powder makes a Singapore noodle style dry curry.

VIETNAMESE CHICKEN NOODLE SALAD

INGREDIENTS

For the Dressing

- 3 Chillies red
- 4 cloves garlic
- 2 tablespoons rice vinegar
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 4 tablespoons fish sauce
- 6 tablespoons lime juice
- 6 tablespoons vegetable oil

For the Salad

- 1/2kg. chicken breasts
- 1pack rice noodles
- some carrots, Zucchini, capsicum
- 1/4 wombok (Chinese cabbage)
- Some bean sprouts too if you like. One large handful of each -- coriander leaves, mint leaves, and spring onions

INSTRUCTIONS

1. DRESSING: Thinly slice the chillies and set aside. Combine all the remaining dressing ingredients. Then add the chillies to the dressing or as a garnish at serving time.
2. Stir fry the chicken and the vegies. But keep the cabbage and bean sprouts for later. Slice them any way that makes you happy!
3. Thinly slice the cabbage. Chop the coriander, mint, and green onions.
4. Toss the chicken, noodles, vegetables, and remaining dressing (to taste) together. Serve immediately.
