Congratulations to the K-2 students running the Easter Hat Parade! What a wonderful job in announcing the items.

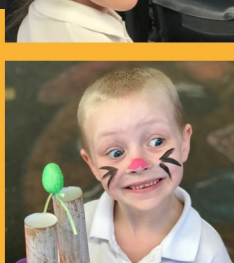
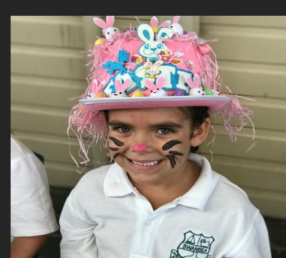
Congratulations to all the students for their creative and interesting hats! It was great to see so many students embrace the 'reuse and recycle' in making their Easter hat creations.

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Cooking with 4/3G

Budget Busting Beef & Bean Cheeseburgers

1 x 400g can of Kidney Beans 300grams Mince
1 larger Carrot, grated your choice of Herbs
1 teaspoon Ground Cumin 1 egg
1 pkt grated Cheese 2 slices of bread each
1 finely chopped Onion (optional)
1 Tbsp Veg or Sunflower Oil, plus 2 Tbsp to fry burgers
1 heaped teaspoon Flour, plus another to shape the burgers

Method

Drain the Kidney Beans and rinse. Put in a saucepan and cover with water. Bring to the boil. Simmer for 10 minutes to really soften

Fry Onion, Carrot, Cumin and Herbs at low heat to soften. Then in a pot combine Beans and Herbs and mash them up. Add the Mince and some flour (eggs too if you like).

Divide the mixture, make into Patties and fry till cooked. Place on Bread, add Cheese and enjoy!
