From the Principal

Dear Parents and Carers

The school has sent out with each student a letter and return slip for you to attend a **Parent/Teacher Conference**. These conferences have been set down for this week, next week and the week after – that is Week 2, 3 and 4 of this term.

This is a great opportunity for parents and carers to come to discuss any issues or concerns that you have with your child's progress. It can also be a time to discuss your child's strengths and where to go next in terms of their learning, before you receive your child's Semester One report at the end of this term. These interviews are expected to last about 15 minutes.

Mrs Stewart has also sent home information on the school's process to develop the annual **Personalised Learning Plans** (PLP) for our Aboriginal students. It is expected that the development of these PLP's will take place during the Parent/Teacher Conference time.

Next week is the week that all schools will be holding **NAPLAN** testing for students in Year 3 and 5. Whilst somewhat controversial, the tests however provide very useful information on individual student progress and also helps the school to attain funding to support students who present with learning difficulties. It is expected that all students in Years 3 and 5 participate unless parents have indicated that they will be away for that week.

We are very lucky at our school to have many available spaces for **parking** around the school. If there are no parking spaces available along Rawson Street, then there are numerous spaces along Galgabba Street. Please park and leave the school zone carefully and be mindful of all our students. Local rangers often patrol the area and will issue fines - parking and traffic infringements are hugely expensive! Let's keep our school zone safe for all our students.

Pumpkin and Zucchini Bake by 4/3G

Ingredients

Butter to grease	700ml of pasta sauce
1 teaspoon of garlic	1 bunch of Spinach, shredded
650g jap pumpkin, cut into slices 2cm thick	3 zucchinis, cut into slices
800g cannellini beans	1/3 cup grated parmesan cheese
35g bread crumbs	Crusty bread to serve

Method:

1. Preheat oven to 220 degrees. Brush ovenproof dish with melted butter to grease.
2. Combine pasta sauce and garlic in a saucepan and cook on medium heat, stirring occasionally for 2 minutes.
3. Add spinach and stir for 30 seconds.
4. Pour a third of the sauce into the ovenproof dish, top with slices of pumpkin and zucchini and half the cannellini beans. Repeat making layers with remaining mixture.
5. Stir together parmesan and breadcrumbs in a bowl and sprinkle over the top of the dish.
6. Bake in the oven for 15 minutes or until golden brown and cooked through.
7. Serve with some crusty bread.
